You do not need to contact anyone for your points to count. All Boulder County 4-H horse participants will be tracked. You must show your project horse(s). Classes shown with non-project horses will not count. You **MUST** attend 2 shows to qualify, however the top scores from three shows will be used in calculating high point. The more shows you attend, the greater advantage there is to win a High Point award.

You **MUST** take the written test at Fair. The written test will be the tie breaker for individual awards and Club participation award.

Classes which are limited to only certain participants (limited by breed of horse, novice-only, etc.) will not count. Note that Showmanship counts for BOTH the English and Western awards.
